FAIRFIELD TOWN HALL MEETING ON UNITED ILLUMINATING'S MONOPOLES: TUESDAY, APRIL 30, 7:30 P.M., ROGER LUDLOWE MIDDLE SCHOOL The fight is not over! With the unprecedented decision by the Siting Council to have United Illuminating move the proposed monopoles from the south side of the railroad tracks to the north, Southport and Fairfield aesthetics are still in danger. 22 acres of permanent easements will be taken, and around 100 monopoles, ranging in size from 95 to 195 feet tall, will still be installed. Please attend this important meeting to find out more and what you can do.
