Due to the Senior High Youth Group's Mission Week being pushed back by a week because of public schools now not finishing until June 20, the Family Mission Trip has been rescheduled to the first full week of July. Join us for a family vacation you won't forget! We now have a long-term lease in a building in Hermosa, South Dakota about 25 minutes north of the Reservation. Let's spend a week together sharing your joy and love with the children of Red Shirt Table (Native America Indian Reservation). Play games, help them learn, become a friend, and bring hope to those who struggle. In addition, you will learn about Native American culture

and visit some of the country's historic sites including Mount Rushmore, Crazy Horse monument and the site of the massacre at Wounded Knee. *Due to the sensitive nature of the Rez, the minimum age is 7*.
