#### UNISON PRAYER OF DEDICATION

We give love, and offer tangible hope to others, because God loves us! We give with cheerful hearts, because we have so much for which we are grateful. Receive these gifts, God, as expressions of our gratitude, to thank you, now and always. If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. If I give away all I have, and if I deliver my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing.
