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GUIDE TO USING AND MASTERING "THE SECRET MAGIC WAND"

1) **<u>DO</u>** it.

"The best meditator or one who prays

...is the one who actually meditates or prays."

2) Take the **TIME**...**SCHEDULE** it.

Just as You <u>Do</u> with anything You <u>Value</u>.

Schedule the time - When you "Go Up to the Mountain" – as it were...

3) **DISMISS** the CROWDS. **UNPLUG.**

Unplug - the **Phone**, the **Email**, the **Music**, the **TV**, your **To Do Lists**, etc.

For a given time – for this 10 min., 30 min.,

unplug your responsible, busy and organizing mind.

And *remember – if Jesus could do it* with all of his responsibilities – *you can.*

You are not more important, more needed or responsible – than Jesus.

4) Go to a **QUIET PLACE** – This is your **MOUNTAIN**

Go to a place where You Will NOT be DISTURBED.

"TREK up the MOUNTAIN"

This may be anywhere you choose where you will (hopefully) not be disturbed. Sit on a CHAIR or the FLOOR with some Support.

5) **GET READY**

CUP your Hands in One Another.

Take a deep breath...and let it go! For as few or as many times as you like.

You might lift your shoulders, and let them drop, or roll your shoulders – releasing any tension.

You might roll your head from around or from side to side – to release tension.

You might – let your jaw drop – and feel that tension release.

6) **BREATHE** –

Just gently notice your breath. In and out of your nose.

Breathing in, pausing by itself for just a moment, and then breathing out.

You notice it happen – all by itself.

Just noticing how you are on automatic pilot.

You are being cared for by God at this moment, and you are surviving.

You are safe.

And for this time "up on the mountain" you do not need to be in charge, or have anything to do.

You might even begin, by recognizing this...and just saying...Ahhhhhhhh...

Just letting it all go – for this sacred time.

7) ALLOW...but NOT FORCE...WHAT NEEDS TO SHIFT - to SHIFT, or FALL AWAY.

You may allow what needs to rise, to rise.

But don't force, or hold on to your thoughts, or get fascinated with your thoughts. Just acknowledge them, and let them drift away – like clouds moving across the sky.

And – return – to your breath. Your peace. Your soul. Your quiet – with God.

8) If You Wish, you <u>MAY OFFER, this TIME</u>: to <u>GOD</u>. To <u>YOU</u>, <u>YOUR SOUL</u>.

This is - NOT - "ME" TIME.

This is **GOD Time**,

This is **SPIRITUAL** – TIME.

This is **HEALTH** Time.

HEALING time.

RECOVERY time.

RENEWAL time.

...Just ask Jesus...!

9) CLOSE your **EYES**.

LET GO.

UNLOAD

ALLOW your CONCERNS - your Hopes, Dreams, Thoughts,

Tears, <u>FEARS</u>, WISHES – for <u>YOURSELF</u> & Those you Love – To ... *FLOW!*

But Nothing is forced.

There may simply be space, quiet, and peace.

10) And YES, YOU MAY Pray for Yourself

Absolutely Pray for Yourself

THAT's NOT SELFISH -

That is Respecting who You are - as One of GOD'S CHILDREN.

11) So a) <u>UNLOAD</u>. <u>LAY It OUT</u> –

- b) Be with God.
- c) CARE FOR YOUR SOUL.
- d) and LISTEN...with your Heart and Soul!!!!

12) GOD WANTS YOU TO TAKE THIS TIME.

THIS is YOUR MOUNTAIN.

Your TIME.

Your LIFE.

And GOOD for ALL.

13) **REPEAT**.

JUST LIKE LEARNING to USE A PENCIL..it TAKES TIME...

MANY MANY TIMES...to Get Used to It.

It MAY NOT FEEL NATURAL or COMFORTABLE AT FIRST.

BE PATIENT with YOURSELF.

JUST DOING IT - AND DOING it AGAIN...is DOING IT "RIGHT".
